New Knowledge:

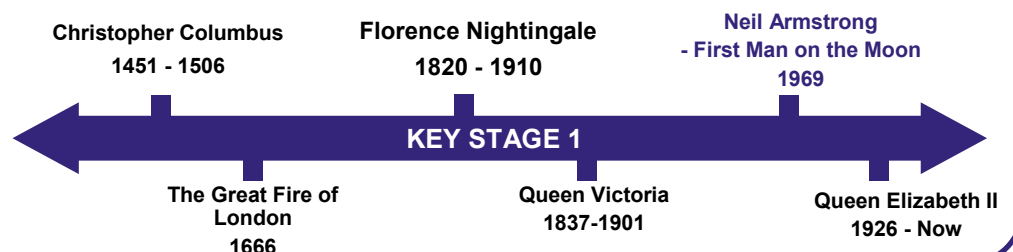
- Major Tim Peake was the first British astronaut to live on the Russian space station 400,000 meters above the Earth.
